The Premier's Awards for Excellence in Education were launched in 2018 to honour the outstanding achievements of public, independent and First Nations school system teachers, principals, vice-principals, administrators and support staff in the K-12 school system.

This year's winners were chosen from 140 nominated teachers, administrators and support staff and announced at a ceremony at Government House in Victoria on October 4. Winners of this year's Premier's Awards for Excellence in Education received a commemorative work of art by Claire Jorgensen, a 17-year-old Reynolds Secondary school student (SD 61, Greater Victoria). They also received a \$3,000 personal bursary for professional learning and a \$2,000 contribution to their school community for professional learning.
